The Delaware Education Research and Development Center seeks applications from an experienced program evaluator with skills in designing and conducting quantitative and qualitative designs. The Educational Researcher for Program Evaluation will be responsible for ongoing program evaluation and applied research in a variety of educational and human services programming.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Designs, manages, and conducts evaluation and applied research projects using both quantitative and qualitative designs. May lead or serve as part of a team in carrying out these projects.
- Supervises graduate student assistants in completing evaluation and research projects.
- Participates in the preparation of proposals for research and evaluation projects; seeks external funding and, when appropriate, serves as principal investigator (PI) and/or co-PI on grant and/or contract proposals.
- Fosters and maintains relationships with clients.
- Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Masters/doctorate and five years relevant experience with an emphasis in program evaluation and/or applied research, research theories and methods, or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
- Excellent empirical analyses and other relevant computer skills.
- Effective written and oral communication skills.
- Ability to work with a variety of individuals from diverse backgrounds and experiences.
- Ability to manage multiple projects simultaneously, meeting strict timelines.
